WOMEN EMPOWERMENT: Challenges and Prospects

What defines a woman? The attributes that might define a woman according to the society are her attire, her skin tone, her culture or the way others perceive or recognize her. In fact, a woman is the creative force of the universe in almost all its aspects.

Life begins in her womb and it finds expressions through her guiding hands that gives immense care and an overall growth.

A STRONG WOMAN BUILDS HER OWN WORLD. How can a woman become strong? It is true that women are courageous and brave. But empowering them becomes icing on the cake as the empowerment adds on the extra benefit and turns the word 'strong' to 'strongest'.

There's a new question. What is empowerment? The granting of the power, right, or authority to perform various acts or duties is what we call empowerment. When someone is empowered, they have the ability to accomplish something, giving them the confidence needed to succeed.

The process by which women gain influence and equal opportunity to pursue personal, social and economic ventures, engaging in all parts of society is known as women empowerment. Women empowerment as a concept was introduced at United Nation's Third World Conference on women in Nairobi in 1985, which defined it as a redistribution of social

and economic powers and control of resources in favor of women. It is regarded as a powerful tool to create a feasible and progressive society.

As empowerment itself means 'giving the power', it helps women to recognize their worth and their right to influence social change for themselves and others. It is said that 'A woman with a voice is, by definition, a strong woman'.

And the most effective tool to give that voice to them is empowerment. Hence, it is nothing but a vision to shine a spotlight on activity uplifting and inspiring women to pursue goals without bias or barriers.

There are few more questions like what are the challenges faced by women in the society or why there is a need of women empowerment? History itself has the answers to these questions. Women from all over the world have been the victims of discriminations, gender stereotypes, violence, assault and many more.

They have been facing inequalities in all the fields irrespective of what type it is or how much effort is required in it. The contradictory situation has been such that she was sometimes concerned as Goddess and at other times merely as slave.

It is rightly said that 'Tremendous amounts of talent are being lost to our society just because that talent wears a skirt'. According to India's National Crime Records Bureau, a crime against women is recorded every 3 minutes, approximately 94 women are raped every day and a young married woman is found beaten to death, burnt or driven to suicide every 6 hours.

These are the reasons why empowering women is essential. The intention is to protect them and to secure their purity and dignity.

Harsh but the truth is that till date it is women who are not being respected and given priorities than that of men. It can be said that patriarchy still remains indirectly active in creating obstacles for women even in today's world. Although these challenges are not faced up to that extent but those are still prevalent in some or the other areas.

It is true that those who try never lose. And the efforts of women to tackle the challenges they face is reflected in the modern world. They are progressing as they are no longer confined within the boundaries of the four walls.

They have been working hard in almost every sector like healthcare, education, sports, financial services and many more. For example, according to a report of United Nations, women have been at the frontlines in the response to COVID-19 as they have played an enormous role in efforts to flatten the curve of infection and position their respective nation for economic recovery.

Let's take another real-life example. People, on social media, keeps on trolling women for various reasons, take for example, their driving skills. However, they forget about females like Kalpana Chawla, who was the first Indian Woman to have been in space. They forget the medals won by P.V. Sindhu, Mary Kom, Mirabai Chanu, Saina Nehwal and many at the international level.

A famous quote by Jawaharlal Nehru that, 'You can tell the condition of a nation by looking at the status of its women' truly defines why women empowerment is a need and essential aspect of today's world. The Convention on the Elimination of all forms of Discrimination Against Women is one of the most important initiatives of the United Nations Organization.

The United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and women empowerment, also known as UN Women has developed a rapid and targeted response to mitigate the impact of the obstacles faced by the females, which includes designing socio-economic plans with an intentional focus on the lives and futures of females.

There are Principles developed through a partnership between UN Women and the United Nations Global Compact, to support companies in reviewing existing policies and practices or establishing new ones, to realize women's empowerment.

Sustainable development also requires efforts and policies to be implemented in favor of women empowerment. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015, provided 17 Sustainable Development Goals. Goal number 5 among those 17 is gender equality, which aims at achieving gender equality and empowering all women and girls by ending all forms of discrimination against all women and girls everywhere and ensuring their full and effective participation in all the spheres.

Comparatively the western part of the world is very liberal about women empowerment. Somehow the western world had some influence on women's empowerment in India. Women have initiated their self-help groups, work in factories, and had their own business.

One good example is the Shri Mahila Griha Udyog Lijjat Papad. This was the first papad business, which was handled and organized by an organization of women. In India, the Ministry of women and Child Development and the National Commission for Women have been working towards Women Empowerment. Today we have different Acts

and Schemes of the central government as well as state government that grant females a power to showcase their true worth.

The list of the acts and schemes includes Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, One-Stop Centre Scheme, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme, Mahila E-Haat Scheme and a lot more.

While women have many glass ceilings to break, these schemes assist them to become more empowered, independent, and safe. Recently, Ministry has launched 'Mission Shakti' – an Integrated Women Empowerment Programme, as an Umbrella Scheme for safety, security and empowerment of women for implementation during the 15th Finance Commission Period 2021-22 to 2025-26.

It seeks to realise the Government's vision for 'women-led development' by addressing issues affecting women on a life-cycle continuum basis and by making them equal partners in nation-building through convergence and citizen-ownership.

What more can be done to enhance this movement? Although the girls in urban areas are almost at par in education with the boys but still there are few parts of the world where education is still far from the hands of women. When one said that 'You educate a man, you educate a man; You educate a woman, you educate a generation,' he or she meant it.

On a personal level, we should begin to appreciate women and provide them with chances equal to males. We must equip them with the tools they need to stand up for themselves and never be victims of injustice.

Commencement of executing programs and campaigns concerning women empowerment via education & other essential rights adds on

the effectivity in the process. Just as the Securities Exchange Board of India has mandated that all listed companies should have at least one-woman director on their board, more such policies will help the ladies to showcase what they have in their bag even in the workplace and the world of corporates.

Adopting appropriate measures to improve women's ability to earn income beyond traditional occupations forms part of the same.

The State and National level commissions for women, Non-Governmental Organizations and even individuals must undertake e-awareness. Along with this, women have to determine ways to create opportunities for them. They must flourish hard to carry out their rights and maintain justice & equality in the community.

It must be not only on 8th of March every year, which is celebrated as International Women's Day, that the ladies of the world are treated with respect but every day they must be made strong by admiring them. Today we have seen women chief ministers, women president, women sports person who are way ahead of many males in terms of the achievements.

The empowerment of women is being regarded these days as a sine-qua-non for the progress of a society and a country as a whole socially, culturally as well as economically. The importance is reflected in the following lines-

Make policies, make them strong, give them control

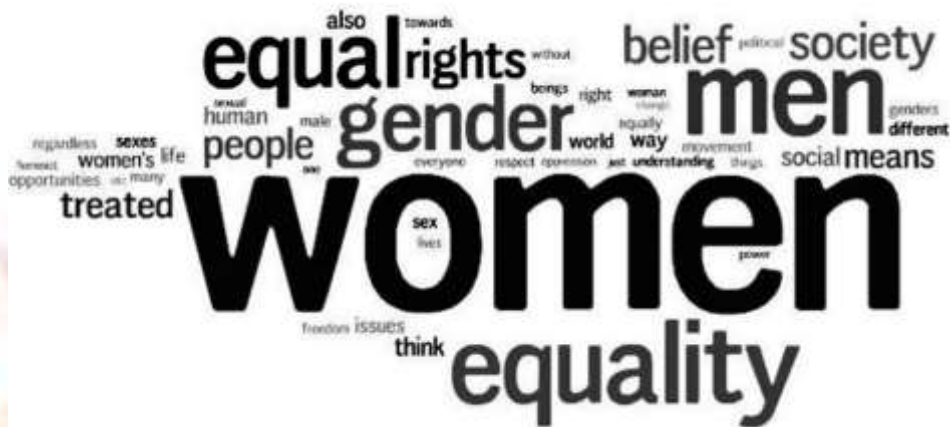
After all, Women Empowerment is the ultimate goal.

CYBER SECURITY

INRODUCTION

Recently while scrolling through my cell phone, I received a notification reading-

“Dear sir, your letter for joining is passed in our company with salary of 75000 pm. Click on the link for more details.” I stood up with sudden joy and excitement, as an article that is getting 1500 pm as stipend, suddenly being offered a job worth of 75000, literally 5 times of my stipend.

As I was about to click on the given link, suddenly then, phrase from recently launched campaign of Google about cyber security with #saferwithgoogle flashed in my mind- “raho doh kadam aagey.” Aur phir maine doh kadam peeche le liye by not clicking that link.

With this century surviving on technology today, these fraudsters and spammers are common and therefore cyber security is an imperative part of our lives.

WHAT IS CYBER SECURITY?

Cyber security is the protection to defend internet-connected devices and services from malicious attacks by hackers, spammers, and cybercriminals. The practice is used by companies to protect against phishing schemes, ransomware attacks, identity theft, data breaches, and financial losses.

Look around today's world, and you'll see that daily life is more dependent on technology than ever before. The benefits of this trend range from near-instant access to information on the Internet to the modern conveniences provided by smart home automation technology and concepts like the Internet of Things.

A steady rise in cybercrime highlights the flaws in devices and services we've come to depend on. This concern forces us to ask what cyber security is and why it's essential. Cyber security is basically a solution to a problem.

But before coming to the solution it is very essential to understand the problem. And the biggest problem is cyber security threat.

TYPES OF CYBER THREATS

Here is a list of common cyber threats:

Cyber terrorism. This threat is a politically-based attack on computers and information technology to cause harm and create widespread social disruption.

Malware. This threat encompasses ransomware, spyware, viruses, and worms. It can install harmful software, block access to your computer resources, disrupt the system, or covertly transmit information from your data storage.

Trojans. Like the legendary Trojan horse of mythology, this attack tricks users into thinking they're opening a harmless file. Instead, once the trojan is in place, it attacks the system, typically establishing a backdoor that allows access to cybercriminals.

Adware. This threat is a form of malware. It's often called advertisement- supported software. The adware virus is a potentially unwanted program (PUP) installed without your permission and automatically generates unwanted online advertisements.

Phishing. Hackers use false communications, especially e-mail, to fool the recipient into opening it and following instructions that typically ask for personal information. Some phishing attacks also install malware.

Man-in-the-middle attack. MITM attacks involve hackers inserting themselves into a two-person online transaction. Once in, the hackers can filter and steal desired data. MITM attacks often happen on unsecured public Wi-Fi networks.

THE SCALE OF THE CYBER SECURITY THREAT

According to Forbes, 2023 will present us with a pack of diverse and terrifying cyber security challenges, everything from supply chain disruption to increased smart device risks.

According to Cybercrime Magazine, cybercrime will cost the world \$10.5 trillion annually by 2025! Furthermore, global cybercrime costs are predicted to rise by almost 15 percent yearly over the next four years.

Recently, On November 23 this year, the premier medical institute in the country, the All India Institute of Medical Sciences New Delhi (AIIMS) was crippled by a major cyberattack. Most of its servers stopped working as also the eHospital network managed by the National Informatics Centre (NIC).

All functions including the emergency, out-patient, in-patient and laboratory wings had to be shifted to manual management.

So it becomes more critical to understand the motive behind the attack and do a review of cyber security preparedness across organizations and systems. Which brings us to the question how does cyber security works?

HOW DOES CYBER SECURITY WORK?

Cyber security encompasses technologies, processes, and methods to defend computer systems, data, and networks from attacks. To best answer the question “what is cyber security” and how cyber security works, we must divide it into a series of subdomains:

Application Security

Application security covers the implementation of different defenses in an organization’s software and services against a diverse range of threats. This sub-domain requires cyber security experts to write secure code, design secure application architectures, implement robust data input validation, and more, to minimize the chance of unauthorized access or modification of application resources.

Cloud Security

Cloud security relates to creating secure cloud architectures and applications for companies that use cloud service providers like Amazon Web Services, Google, Azure, Rackspace, etc.

Mobile Security

Mobile security is a big deal today as more people rely on mobile devices. This subdomain protects organizational and personal information stored on mobile devices like tablets, cell phones, and laptops from different threats like unauthorized access, device loss or theft, malware, viruses, etc. In addition, mobile security employs authentication and education to help amplify security.

Network Security

Network security covers hardware and software mechanisms that protect the network and infrastructure from disruptions, unauthorized access, and other abuses. Effective network security protects organizational assets against a wide range of threats from within or outside the organization.

Disaster Recovery and Business Continuity Planning

Not all threats are human-based. The DR BC subdomain covers processes, alerts, monitoring, and plans designed to help organizations prepare for keeping their business-critical systems running during and after any sort of incident (massive power outages, fires, natural disasters), and resuming and recovering lost operations and systems in the incident's aftermath.

User Education

Knowledge is power, and staff awareness of cyber threats is valuable in the cyber security puzzle. Giving business staff training on the fundamentals of computer security is critical in raising awareness about industry best practices, organizational procedures and policies,

monitoring, and reporting suspicious, malicious activities. This subdomain covers cyber security-related classes, programs, and certifications.

Having understood how does cyber security works, it is very important to effectively plan and strategize cyber security process.

There is no one size fits all approach when creating a cyber-security strategy as every business need is unique.

In this section, we walk through 8 steps that your organization can use as a model

to develop and implement a successful security strategy:

1. Conduct A Security Risk Assessment
2. Set Your Security Goals
3. Evaluate Your Technology
4. Select A Security Framework
5. Review Security Policies
6. Create A Risk Management Plan
7. Implement Your Security Strategy
8. Evaluate Your Security Strategy

Step 1: Conduct A Security Risk Assessment

An IT enterprise security risk assessment is performed for organizations to assess, identify, and modify their overall security posture. A

comprehensive enterprise security risk assessment also helps determine the value of the various types of data generated and stored across the organization.

Without valuing the various types of data in the organization, it is nearly impossible to prioritize and allocate technology resources where they are needed the most.

To accurately assess risk, management must identify the data sources that are most valuable to the organization, where the storage is located, and their associated vulnerabilities.

Step 2: Set Your Security Goals

A key component of the cyber security strategy is to ensure that it aligns or is in step with the business goals of the company.

Once the business goals are established, the implementation of a proactive cyber security program for the entire organization can commence.

Various areas that can assist in creating the security goals:

Determining Your Security Maturity, Understanding Your Company's Risk Appetite, Setting Reasonable Expectations and much more.

Step 3: Evaluate Your Technology

Another key component of the cyber security strategy is the evaluation of technology.

Once the assets have been identified, the next step(s) are to determine if these systems meet security best practices, understand how they

function on the network, and who supports the technology within the business.

Step 4: Select a Security Framework

There are multiple frameworks available today that can help you create and support the cyber security strategy; however, you can't secure what you can't see, but the results of the cyber security risk assessment, vulnerability assessment, and penetration test can help you determine which framework to select.

The security framework will provide guidance on the controls needed to continuously monitor and measure the security posture of your organization.

Step 5: Review Security Policies

The goal of security policies is to address security threats and implement cyber security strategies. An organization may have one overarching security policy, along with specific sub policies to address various technologies in place at the organization.

To ensure security policies are up to date and address emerging threats, a thorough review of the policies is recommended.

Step 6: Create a Risk Management Plan

Creating a risk management plan is an essential component of the cyber security strategy. This plan provides an analysis of potential risks that may impact the organization.

The following policies below are examples of best practice policies that can be incorporated into your risk management plan.

Data Privacy Policy – Provides governance around the handling of corporate data is handled and secured properly.

Retention Policy – Describes how various types of corporate data should be stored or archived, where, and for how long.

Data Protection Policy – This policy states how the business handles the personal data of its employees, customers, suppliers, and other third parties.

Incident Response Plan – This plan outlines the responsibilities and procedures that should be followed to ensure a quick, effective and orderly response to Security Incidents.

Step 7: Implement Your Security Strategy

At this stage of the strategy, assessments are near completion along with policy plans. It is now time to prioritize remediation efforts and assign tasks to teams.

Step 8: Evaluate Your Security Strategy

This final step in the creation of the cyber security strategy is the start of an ongoing support of the security strategy.

Threat actors will continue to exploit vulnerabilities regardless of the size of the organization.

It is imperative that the security strategy be monitored and tested regularly to ensure the goals of the strategy align with the threat landscape.

SOLUTIONS AND INITIATIVES TO SAFEGUARD INDIA'S CYBERSECURITY JOURNEY

To tackle cyber threats on an urgent basis, the government and industry players have built capabilities that are being driven by advanced AI and ML solutions.

Typically, these tools rely on large volumes of digital transaction data to detect and prevent fraudulent transactions to prevent hacks. Algorithms are used to track and analyze large transactions, detect suspicious activity in user accounts, and send alerts.

Behavioral analytics and passive biometrics are key to identifying good users versus bad actors, for example, the way the user is holding the phone, typing speed, device attributes etc.

AI/ ML help in analyzing data from millions of cyber incidents and using it to identify potential threats or a new variant of malware.

Today, there are risk mitigation tools designed for small businesses with self-scan capability. They enable businesses to scan their websites for potential cyber vulnerabilities by simply running them from a portal, much like how one uses an antivirus for devices.

Such tools leverage open-source intelligence by employing passive, non-invasive techniques to discover the organization's public systems and to analyse the cybersecurity risk posture of those systems. This increases the frequency of scans without any disruption to business and these capabilities help organizations recognize any gaps before the criminals and address risks.

CONCLUSION

As data breaches, hacking, and cybercrime reach new heights, companies increasingly rely on cyber security experts to identify potential threats and protect valuable data. So it makes sense that the cyber security market is expected to grow from \$217 billion in 2021 to \$345 billion by 2026, posting a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 9.7% from 2021 to 2026.

As cyber security will continue to remain a potent factor in India's digital ecosystem, all stakeholders must focus on a collaborative approach to develop formidable solutions that can create safer digital spaces.

The role of policymakers will be equally crucial as they can help the industry in catalyzing innovation and bringing new solutions to the market at a faster pace and with enhanced agility.

सफर तेरा है खत्म भी तुझे ही करना है।

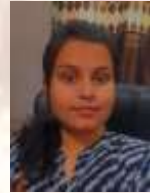
ना डरना है ना झुकना है, बस आगे बढ़ना है,
