THE FINANCIAL INDUSTRY AND THE USE OF BLOCKCHAIN TECHNOLOGY

BLOCKCHAIN TECHNOLOGY

Blockchain is the technology that creates a ledger of transactions on the internet that is secure, tamper-proof, and easily accessible. Blockchain technology is one of the most new innovations of the digital age. Initially it was developed for Bitcoin, but now whether you are working in supply chains, manufacturing processes, record management, healthcare, retail space, land registration, verifying ownership, IoT devices, public ledger, equity swap or any other industries. Blockchain could help you in getting a competitive edge. Its ability to secure and decentralize data has led to its adoption in business processes, improving efficiency, transparency, and security.

Now let explore how block chain is used in Financial Industry.

Efficient Payments & Secure

Blockchain can improve payment transparency, efficiency, and security as well as reduce the cost for financial services firms and users. Earlier, the payments from one entity to another entity used to take up to a week time, with the help of block chain it is transferred instantly. The use of digital currencies and distributed ledger technologies make payment faster, cheaper, and more convenient. One of the main benefits of block chain technology is its ability to secure transactions. Traditional methods of transferring assets, such as wire transfers, are prone to fraud and hacking. However, block chain technology enables secure peer-to-peer transactions without the need for intermediary. The transactions are secured by complex cryptography.

Quicker settlement in stock markets / Financials

On February 15, 2023, the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") adopted a rule amendment to shorten the standard settlement cycle for most routine securities trades from two business days after the trade date to one business day after the trade date (or from "T+2" to "T+1" in common parlance). Major stock exchanges are exploring the potential of blockchain to allow almost immediate stock settlements by reducing transaction time and operational cost. NASDAQ uses blockchain technology to issue and share private securities,

while the London Stock Exchange is exploring blockchain opportunities with cross-industry groups of institutions to change the way securities are being traded in Europe.

EKYC - Digital Identity Verification

Blockchain technology can be used to create secure digital identities that can be verified without the need for intermediaries. This can help reduce identity theft and fraud, as well as improve the efficiency of identity verification processes.

Supply Chain for Asset Management

Blockchain technology is also being used to improve supply chain management. It also improves transparency in the supply chain, allowing customers to trace the origin of the products they purchase. Today, the asset management and supply chain network largely focuses on a centralized digital system that gives real-time visibility of assets within our systems. The distributed ledger concept enables direct trading and settlements across boundaries, it helps in reducing cost, increasing data accuracy, and reducing delays in processes. It makes you vulnerable to errors, fraud, and misinterpretation during an exchange of assets between parties

Agreement / Contracts with Clients

Agreement / contracts are self-executing contracts with the terms and Conditions and in agreement between buyer and seller being directly written into lines of code. This means that the contract automatically executes when the conditions of the agreement are met. Contracts enable secure and transparent transactions, reducing the need for intermediaries and improving efficiency in business process of Client On boarding Journey.

Data Management with Regulators

Blockchain technology can help businesses manage data securely and transparently, ensuring data accuracy and compliance with privacy regulations. It offers a decentralized network that makes it difficult for hackers to tamper with or steal data. Financials organizations are using blockchain to securely store and manage data as required by regulators for Clients.

Conclusion

The financial services industry is moving towards blockchain adoption, it is an innovation that has revolutionized the global financial system and making it more secure and efficient. There are many ways in which blockchain technology is enhancing the global financial service industry. Its ability to secure transactions and Efficient Payments, improve supply chain management for Asset management, EKYC – Digital Identity Verification makes it a valuable tool for businesses of all sizes. BEGINNING – F.Y. 2023-24

As we are moving towards new financial year, and in this new financial year we need to manage multiple things from compliances point of view. From GST Point I am going to share with you certain important aspects which we need to know while closing the financial 2022-23 and also for new beginning (i.e. F.Y. 2023-24). Let's Start our discussion in certain points :

1.Invoice Series : From 01-04-2023 we need to generate new invoice series. One important aspect is that we need to generate invoice series in such a way that financial year must be included in that series. Also generate fresh series for debit, credit note and include F.Y. with that series also.

Example : Invoice – 01/2023-24

Debit Note – DN01/2023-24

Credit Note – CN01/2023-24

2.Reconciliation of Input Balances : Reconcile your Closing input tax credit balances of Books with Balances in Electronic credit ledger for 31.03.2023 and if there is any difference exists then prepare working regarding that difference and put the same on records. Which will be very much helpful during income tax audit as well as during Annual Returns under GST.

3.Sales Reconciliation : This is also an important task, Reconcile your sales as per books with your sales on GSTN Portal (i.e. GSTR -3B & GSTR -1) if you found any rectification in your GSTR -1 and GSTR -3B in that case you should do these rectification with your March 2023 Month Returns, don't wait for November 2023. This procedure will helps you a lot during your income tax audit as well as during GSTR-9/9C.

4.Input Reconciliation : As we all know that input tax credit is the heart of GST. In Current scenario maximum litigations are only due to input tax credit hence this is my humble submissions to all of you that reconcile your input tax credit figure of Books with Input tax credit claimed in GSTR-3B and input tax credit reflected in GSTR-2B. if you found any differences in that case prepare reconciliation between all of them and make the necessary adjustments in your GSTR -3B of March 2023 Month itself.

5.Accounting- GSTR -2B V. Books : - As we all know that we need to claim input tax credit as per GSTR – 2B only. So, for proper reconciliation on monthly basis, for that purpose we need to make certain changes in our accounting process also. One important change is that we need to create one new ledger in books named “Unclaimed Input Tax Credit”. For a particular month if certain input is not available in GSTR-2B in that case we should transfer that particular input in that “unutilised input tax credit” ledger so that those entries will be traceable. In next month if those entries reflected in GSTR -2B in that case we should claim the same in GSTR-3B and make necessary entries in books for transferring that input from unutilised input tax credit ledger to respective ledger.

6.Section 49(12) : This section is very much relevant and crucial for our day to day practices. During Business Audit/Departmental Audits in many cases department initiated proceeding regarding non fulfilment of section 49(12) and raise huge amount of demand on account of failure. As per section 49(12) if for a particular month turnover of an entity exceeds 50 lakh rupees in that case entity needs to pay 1% of total tax liability in cash (i.e. Electronic Cash Ledger) Although there are certain exceptions available regarding this section. We need to be carefully examine the situation and check the Applicability of Section 49(12). Implications of this section is really very huge.

7.Reconciliation between HSN Summary and Sales : This is also an important aspect. when we are going to file our GSTR-1 Return we needs to be very much careful. we should match taxable sales with sales as per HSN Code. And also if turnover exceeds 5 crore in that case 6 digit HSN Code is mandatory and turnover upto 5 crore turnover 4 digit HSN Code in mandatory.

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATIONS DATED 31.03.2023 :

1.Notification No. 2/2023 Waiver of late fees for GSTR -4 : Now, we can file our GSTR-4 Return (Composition Taxable person) without any late fees till 30th June 2023 regarding f.y. 2019-20 to f.y. 2021-22 and also for the period July 2017 to March 2019.

2.Notification No. 03/2023 Revocation of Registration :- If registration of any person has been cancelled till 31st December 2022 then in that case we can file revocation application till 30th June 2023, Only condition is that up to effective date of cancellation all the returns with interest and late fees has to be filed.

3.Notification No. 06/2023 Assessment of Non Return Filers : if department has issued order under section 62 of CGST Act as non Return Filers in that case if taxpayer is going to file all the returns till 30th June 2023 in that Department will withdrawn order under section 62 of CGST Act.

4.Notification No. 7/2023 – Annual Return late fees Reduction : Government has reduced late fees on Previous Period Annual Return, if the same has been filed till 30th June 2023. the reduces late fees is as follows :

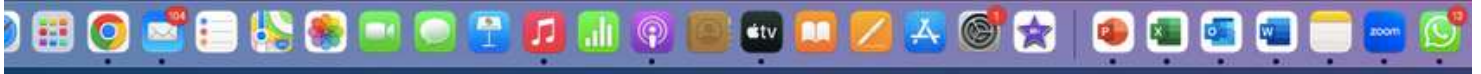
Turnover	Late Fees
Up to 5 Crore	25 Rs. Per Day or 0.02% of turnover (Whichever is lower)
5 Crore up to 20 Crore	50 Rs. per day or 0.02% of turnover (Whichever is lower)

Maximum Late fees is rs. 10,000
